USE YOUR CREATIVE IDEAS, THOUGHTS AND EMOTIONS TO MAKE SOMETHING TANGIBLE AND MEANINGFUL – FOCUSING ON THE VALUE OF THE EXPERIENCE IN TANKWA TOWN, RATHER THAN THE RESULT.

AFRIKABURN IS NOT BOUND BY THE USUAL LINEAR DIMENSIONS OF THE DEFAULT WORLD. LISTED EVENTS CAN OFTEN OCCUR EARLIER OR LATER THAN LISTED, SO, PLEASE, SWAP YOUR EXPECTATIONS FOR APPRECIATIONS, AND FOCUS ON CREATING SOMETHING FUN AND FULFILLING IN THE PRESENT.

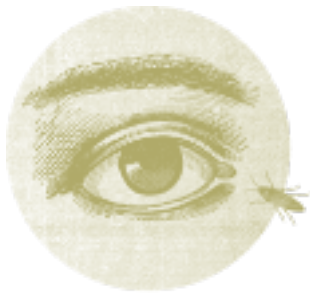
REMEMBER ... BEING CREATIVE = LACK OF CONTROL.





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AN ACT AS SIMPLE AS INSPIRATION, as playful as a child's game, as dangerous as an untamed anvil, CREATION IS a rite of passage. It can reflect the seemingly insignificant and mundane aspects of life, requiring no special skill or grand visions, while the value of such creation is not in its commodity or institutional worth but in its limitless potential and accessibility. It strives for the singular and non-dramatic qualities of a simple natural event, a game or a gag. It is a confluence of you and an impromptu skit, a playful prank, a gift without pause, a child's drawing or *[insert your CREATION here]*.

SURREAL and ABSURD reveals a reality more profound than the mundane. It calls on us to traverse the wanderland and explore the uncharted realms of our subconscious, to forge the rational with the irrational, the dreams with reality, until we break down the walls that confine our IMAGINATION.

In Tankwa Town, every being is a cosmic creator with the power to transform their reality. The Karoo canvas is vast, the palette infinite. Let no idea be too outrageous, no dream too big, no journey too far. We are the architects, sculptors, poets, and dreamers in the grand design of existence. Embrace the extraordinary in the ordinary, find beauty in chaos, and see the truth in paradox. In our home, let your spirit dance, your mind wander, and your heart sing.

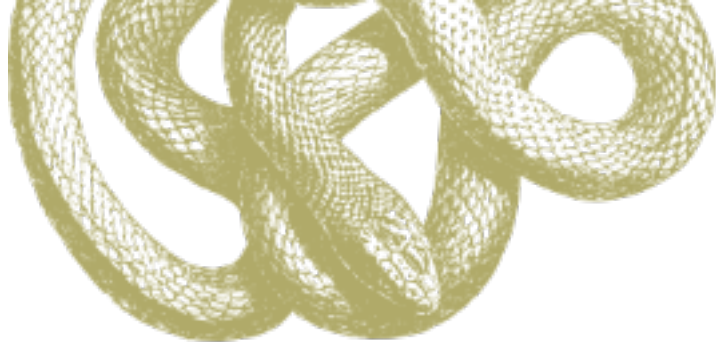
DESTROY THE PAST BY CREATING SOMETHING NEW

Build a community and stand up for civic responsibility. **I CAN** create response and resistance - and be prepared to **DEFEND** others' experience. Show others the **FLAME** within themselves and keep it burning bright. **PROTECT** one another as we do our culture.



YOU ARE AN ARTIST, a child of the cosmos, a dreamer of worlds, shadows and light, a kaleidoscope of experiences. The creative force that ignited the stars and birthed galaxies also beats within your chest. The spark of ideas, the essence of **CREATION**, lives within us all.



AfrikaBurn is an official Burning Man regional event held in South Africa since 2007. Our home is in the Western Cape portion of the Tankwa Karoo. The Guiding Principles of AfrikaBurn stem directly from Burning Man but in our usual South African way, we've adapted them for Tankwa Town, and created an extra one for good measure.

COMMUNAL EFFORT

Our community values creative cooperation and collaboration. We strive to produce, promote and protect social networks, public spaces, works of art, and methods of communication that support such interaction.

CIVIC RESPONSIBILITY

We value civil society. Community members who organise events should assume responsibility for public welfare and endeavour to communicate civic responsibilities to participants. They must also assume responsibility for conducting events in accordance with national and local laws.

DECOMMODIFICATION

In order to preserve the spirit of gifting, our community seeks to create social environments that are unmediated by commercial sponsorships, transactions or advertising. We stand ready to protect our culture from such exploitation. We resist the substitution of consumption for participatory experience.

PARTICIPATION

Our community is committed to a radically participatory ethic. We believe that transformative change, whether in the individual or in society, can occur only through the medium of deeply personal participation. We achieve being through doing. Everyone is invited to work. Everyone is invited to play. We make the world real through actions that open the heart.

IMMEDIACY

Immediate experience is, in many ways, the most important touchstone of value in our culture. We seek to overcome barriers that stand between us and a recognition of our inner selves, the reality of those around us, participation in



society, and contact with a natural world exceeding human powers. No idea can substitute for this experience.

GIFTING

We are devoted to acts of gift giving. The value of a gift is unconditional. Gifting does not contemplate a return or an exchange for something of equal value.

LEAVING NO TRACE

Our community respects the environment. We are committed to leaving no physical trace of our activities wherever we gather. We clean up after ourselves and endeavour, whenever possible, to leave such places in a better state than when we found them.

RADICAL SELF-EXPRESSION

Radical self-expression arises from the unique gifts of the individual. No one other than the individual or a collaborating group can determine its content. It is offered as a gift to others. In this spirit, the giver should respect the rights and liberties of the recipient.

RADICAL SELF-RELIANCE

AfrikaBurn encourages the individual to discover, exercise and rely on their inner resources.



RADICAL INCLUSION*

Everyone should be able to be a part of AfrikaBurn. As an intentional community, committed to inventing the world anew, we actively pursue mechanisms to address imbalances and overcome barriers to participation, especially in consideration of past, current and systemic injustice. We welcome and respect the stranger. Anyone can belong.

EACH ONE TEACH ONE

As a self-reliant community, we believe the responsibility of spreading our culture lies with each and every one of us. All of us are custodians of our culture – when the opportunity presents itself, we pass knowledge on.

These principles aren't commandments, and they're not rules – they are ideals that offer guidelines for how we as a community can reinvent the world, and ourselves. They are designed to enhance your experience in Tankwa Town as well as live in harmony with your fellow burners.

In summary, don't be kak, just be lekker.

**In early April 2019, after consultations with Burning Man Project's team, and in response to our organisation's wish to acknowledge that the principle of Radical Inclusion (as originally set out by Larry Harvey in 2004) would benefit from a recontextualisation that reflected the South African context, the content of that principle was changed to the text you now see reflected above.*



For lots of you reading this ... everything is brand new! This is only our third time on our new site, and our third large scale event since the world ended and started again.

The default world is a challenging place - many of us are still recovering from the past few years. Keep this in mind when you join the city - there's space for forgiveness, education and understanding in Tankwa Town - and it might take some time for the magic Tankwa Karoo dust to seep into our veins. We need to remember that AfrikaBurn is not for the faint of heart, that the desert genuinely wants to kill you and if you don't stay hydrated you're going to bottom out a few hours after you've finished this sentence.

As we step into the beginning, we ask you to take your citizenship in Tankwa Town seriously. Take your Creative Licence out, and be brave, lose yourself in the dust, and find yourself in the smiles of other people. Make sure you're here not to show people how cool you are, but to show THEM how cool THEY are.

Take a moment to reconnect with the 11 Principles that make this temporary autonomous zone so special. This is your best AfrikaBurn. Take good care of each other, take small sips and small steps, take your time and give others the time they may need to repressurise.



We've made AfrikaBurn hard again

The new supplier process has seen many private spaces opened up, more industrious participants, and as a result, there are more creative projects, happenings, mutant vehicles and theme camps than ever before ...

There is an updated sound policy which can be found towards the back of this booklet. It's all in the interests of enjoying AfrikaBurn as much as possible, and making sure that if anyone does want to sleep, they can. *Don't be a doef doef doos.*

The sand has moved (again)

Quaggafontein and Vaalfontein are very much a creative hodgepodge. They're the leftovers from the beginning of time. There are sections of grassy dunes dotted around Tankwa Town, hard rocky bits, and lots and lots of sand. Tread lightly, treat the planet with respect, and please don't forget to leave no trace.

If your vehicle gets stuck in the sand, please ask for help from your campmates and neighbours. We don't have tow trucks on site, so you're going to have to maak 'n plan.

We're not planning your Burn for you

In the annual event survey (please see page 65), we often get asked about publishing the WTF? booklet weeks before the event, and giving participants a weekly planner so they can maximise their pancake intake as well as catch all the headline performers. Because this goes against our principle of Immediacy, we are very careful not to do this ... CREATION is a blank canvas for you to explore and create your own adventure. Don't worry about what you might be missing on the other side of the Binnekring; take comfort in being in the present, be open...

No one wants to be photographed before you ask them

In previous years at AfrikaBurn, you needed to get a pink 'No Photo' wristband if you wanted your desire not to have your photo taken in Tankwa Town to be made visible. We often ran out of these bracelets, so not everyone in Tankwa Town could have one.



We've made lots more, and these wristbands are still available at the gate (until they run out!), but we've found that these bracelets have not always stopped people from past events showing up unexpectedly in social media posts online when they're radically expressing themselves.

This year, (which is technically exactly the same as EVERY year) the agreement upon entering Tankwa Town is that all participants at AfrikaBurn have **not** given their consent to be photographed, whether they are wearing a pink wristband or not. *If you want a picture of someone, please ask and get permission first.*





Artefactory

A museum of all things from the CREATION of AfrikaBurn - a mélange for explorers seeking to learn the history of AfrikaBurn, the 11 Principles, previous events, creative initiatives, and Miss Nesbitt's memoirs, all of which are detailed in displays in a giant shipping container. It also has the best rooftop viewing deck where you can sit and watch the wonders of CREATION unfold.

Arteria

Got art? This is where you check in with our Art Wranglers to get advice on placement and assistance from volunteers. It's also where you can find a (generally updated) large map of all the registered artworks. The Burn Schedule chalkboard is also here with updated burn times throughout the day.

Are you bringing a Creative Project to Tankwa Town? Please come to the Arteria when you arrive (it does not matter if you registered your project in advance or not).

Do you want to know more about any of the creative projects in Tankwa Town? Come to the Arteria. *Do you need help with your project? Do you want to help with a project?* Come to the Arteria. *Are you burning your artwork and/or would you like to volunteer to do the fire perimeter?* Come to the Arteria. *Do you want to let the town know about your performance or activity?*

Or do you want to know about all the performances and activities in town? Come to the Arteria.

Are you a Theme Camp lead looking for an ice card? Come to the Arteria. Do you have lots of fuel to manage? Come to the Arteria. Not sure what constitutes 'lots of fuel'? Come to the Arteria.

After the event and when you're leaving Tankwa Town and need to get your spot signed off & verified by the Leave No Trace Team (compulsory for all theme camps and artworks)? Come to the Arteria. Anything else that you can think of that is even just vaguely tangentially related to creative projects? Come to the Arteria.

Simply put: *no matter what you want, just come to the Arteria. Open from 9am to 3pm every day from 24 April to 7 May.*

Chillaz

Chillaz is the heartbeat of CREATION - AfrikaBurn's Official Off-Centre Camp stage and a platform for artists, creatives and dreamers to share their gifts with the community.



Experience a vibrant mix of cultures from around Mzansi (and the rest of the world), step into a co-created space where you're not just a guest, but a part of the performance. From the crack of dawn until midnight (and beyond), Chillaz is a creative hub of music, art, storytelling and more.

Start your day with AfroFusion dance classes, or dive into our thought-provoking Theta-Praat Speaker series. Groove to the rhythms of live bands in the afternoon sun, and as twilight falls, let the Afro House, Amapiano, Reggae and Dub beats carry you into the night.

Open from 8am to Midnight, Monday to Wednesday and Sunday, and from 8am to 2am Thursday to Saturday.

From screenprinting to boardgames to coffee to doccies, music and magic, and people and participation, Chillaz is where you belong.



Collexodus

In the aftermath of a spectacular week of joy, tears and far more water than you've ever drunk in your life, as we gather the remnants of our collective experience, it's common to find yourself with surplus supplies that you no longer need - good food, warm drinks, libations and treats, camping gear, and a host of other things you never expected you'd be responsible for. This is where Collexodus comes in.

At Collexodus, the Department of Public Works (DPW) steps up to gather these leftover items that can find new life elsewhere. We're here to lighten your load and ensure these resources don't go to waste.

Here's how we put your donations to use: *Unopened canned and dry food?* Those head straight to Karoo families and schools, spreading love beyond our event borders. *Good, usable camping equipment* becomes part of our resource base for Radical Inclusion, ensuring everyone has the chance to participate fully. *Unopened snacks and booze?* They give our hardworking DPW crew a well-deserved break, fueling their efforts to keep the magic alive.

And of course, by parting with these items, you're lightening your load for a safer journey home.

As we come to the pack up and strike portion of the week's fandango, you can keep an eye out for roving Collexodus vehicles, that will make rounds on Sunday morning. We're here to save you the hassle and fuel of lugging your unneeded donations to Exit Road. And if you miss the Collexodus tent on Exit Road where some DPW folk will help receive contributions and help sort through what we accept.

What we DO accept:

Closed dry goods: pasta, rice, instant sauces, tea, etc.

Unopened alcohol
Working, good quality camping gear:
blankets, tents, chairs, couches, etc.

Anything open
Any perishable fresh food
Any open and previously eaten snack
The plague is real!
Open alcohol and boxed wine
Anything broken or not in working condition/dirty

Department of Mutant Vehicles

If you've brought a Mutant Vehicle this is where you come to license it to drive in Tankwa Town. Remember to bring your registration number. Meet sporty horny creatives in short skirts handing out traffic fines at light-speed. The home of the Skollie Patrollie, the smell of LRP and relatively-delicious craft beer. Located between 5ish and 6ish.

Die Yskas

Our ice station, where you can find the only thing sold in Tankwa Town. Open daily from 10am to 1pm, Monday to Saturday. **Ice this year costs R100 for a 5kg bag.** The entrance is by Off-Centre Camp on the Binnekking, so that's where the line starts. Please leave your bike on the bicycle rack, and your car at your campsite. Bring a buddy to help you carry or if you're getting a lot of bags, speak to the Art Car people - they are generally very happy to help with a drive-by icing.

By Wednesday/Thursday we are tired of explaining all of the above and we are sleep deprived so we might get a little snippy. Remember that that the beasts of the Yskas can be soothed with adult beverages (don't worry, we've got our own ice).

PRO TIP: *bring a container - gym bag/backpack/beach bag/foldable cooler bags to make carrying easy.*

Leave No Trace

Our eco-warrior volunteer team that makes sure we turn Tankwa Town back into the Tankwa Karoo.

Quaggafontein is a private nature reserve and a curated, safe space for radical self-expression. Let's honour this place by treading gently upon the dusty landscape and leaving nothing but footprints and positive energy.

Help with the MOOP SWOOP! Look out for the MOOP crew gathering by the Volunteer Booth at OCC, with their

MOOP bags in hand and set off all around the Binnekking to spread the joy of Leave No Trace. This procession is a lot of fun, so pull in, dress up, and let's do the MOOP SWOOP! Did we mention it's a pub crawl too?

Bring your MOOP bags and your buddies, and don't worry if you don't have either of these, they'll be provided.



Medics?

Hangovers, headaches and hang nails? Sorry, but these are not emergencies. Please practice self-reliance by bringing and making use of your own medical kits for minor issues. Do not, we repeat, DO NOT forget to take your chronic meds too. For real emergencies, our medics have got you covered. Look for the big red cross, and please inform your campmates of where they can find them if needed. **Located at Off-Centre Camp.**

Off-Centre Camp (OCC)

The OCC is the centre of CREATION, where people meet and most things related to volunteering happen. It's the community hub of our event and an open space for everybody who wants to be involved.

The Volunteer Booth is where volunteers check-in and can sign up for a shift and get specific event information.

OCC is also home to Just In(e), our Lost & Found hut. Need to hook up with a friend? Find a lift? Leave a note? Draw a rude picture? There are chalkboards galore at OCC to do just that.

The OCC area is open from 9am to 5pm the weekend before gates open, 9am to 7pm Monday to Wednesday of the event and 9am to 5pm Thursday to Monday. Community-run services at the OCC have different operating hours, so please check individual times ... Chillax might be jamming until midnight, and Radio Free Tankwa might be reading bedtime stories at 2am. Come and visit, chill, enquire, sign up or just shoot the breeze. Come on over, we can't wait to meet you.

Radio Free Tankwa

Tune into 99.9FM anywhere in CREATION: we're LIVE on air every day from 9(ish) to 6(ish) with important news, weather, Burn schedules, interviews with artists and participants, updates on project schedules and a great line-up of DJs and tunes.

Our radio schedule chalkboards (and brains) are wiped clean every day at 10am, when we open up hour-long broadcast slots during the day until about 5pm. You and your crew can come through and hijack the airwaves ... play all your favourite pancake-inspired songs, kakkpraat, whatever. All you need to do to sign up, is come through to our caravan



at OCC at 10am(ish) and put your name down with one of the RFT team.

The RFT crew love it when you pop past our caravan with cold beers, announcements and reminders. We're always very happy to do a quick interview or update ... you may be gifting drinks at 5pm or gathering for a sunset shindig at your artwork - we can ~~test your cocktails~~ announce it on the air and make sure everyone knows where and when to be on the Binnekring. *Radio Free Tankwa* is also your first source of information in an emergency situation.



Rangers

Rangers are here to help the AfrikaBurn community feel connected in the harsh, isolated beauty of the Tankwa Karoo. Rangers are burners who volunteer in Tankwa Town to look after the safety and wellbeing of everyone. Their gift is time, skills and energy in promotion of the 11 Principles.

To join the Rangers, lovingly known as 'The Orange' you'll need patience, empathy, good communication skills, and a positive attitude. You also need to have attended Ranger training.

Come and learn how to help your fellow burners help themselves navigate challenges through mediating, providing information, and just being a friendly face in the desert.

Sanctuary

A safe space located next to the Medics at OCC, Sanctuary volunteers create a safe and supportive space where participants who need a break from overwhelm can get some quiet. The space is run by volunteers trained in peer support for challenging, overwhelming, or emotional experiences. Rest, refreshment and company are available inside or at the fire. Guests can stay for a few hours, and then campmates can help them get back to camp to rest. *Condoms are also available 24/7 at the Sanctuary.*

Safety education and information is available from 12pm to 6pm at the Harm Reduction Hub next door.

Toilets

Look for the chimneys and lights. If it didn't come outta your body, it doesn't go in the potty. Our throne toilets are all round the edge of the camping areas and some are in the Binnekring. Use them! No more longdrops or porta potties - get on your throne and you'll still get a lovely view.

The toilets are kitted with tampon bins: use those rather than chucking tampons in toilets, thanks.

AND PLEASE PUT THE PAPER BACK IN THE BUCKET. If you don't, the wind will create toilet snakes (white paper ribbons) all over the Tankwa, which is severely kak for our LNT crew (who like real snakes, not paper ones).

During the rollout of the event, like during Build Week, or early in the event week, we tend to keep some of the toilets battened shut (this is so that we can reduce pumping, cleaning, and maintenance, as well as to reduce smell), so please respect the closed loos, and don't open them up for general use.

There are also a number of toilets placed in Tankwa Town specifically for our disabled participants. These toilets are for those who have requested and need them.

Outreach

Organising efforts to aid communities that live in and around the areas of AfrikaBurn's operations, Outreach has a primary focus on preserving and conserving the culture of the Tankwa, through education enrichment, community upliftment and animal welfare. Outreach facilitates donations of food and equipment, directly funds activities and works in partnership with other organisations.

See Collexodus for details of collection and drop off for donations of non-perishable food for the Elandslei NGK Skool pantry.

Donated bikes can be left at the bike racks near the site office (a big bus) for Tankwa community distribution in collaboration with Pedals for Peace.

Volunteers

Volunteer shifts are absolutely the best way to get the best times at AfrikaBurn ... you'll meet new people, make new friends, learn new skills, discover stuff about yourself, and try new things beyond your comfort zone! It may change your life. It may even change your heart, and give you a better sense of the Burn by building a deeper relationship with the community. *Come and get involved!*

It takes nearly 4 000 shifts to run this city – and the volunteer opportunities are endless: Greeters, Leave No Trace, Die Hek, Lost & Found, Fire Perimeter, Radio Free Tankwa etc are all the OG pieces of our edgeless puzzle! Pretty much everyone around is volunteering, so head over to the Volunteer Booth at OCC and prepare to be welcomed with open arms!

Come and visit our new hub this year. It has daily activations like fire jams, flow arts, games, a conscious cinema and fireside chats. It's a hearty homey space for you to unwind, chill out, play... and make some super groovy connections.



This is how it works: everything you see in Tankwa Town – including all the artworks, theme camps, mutant vehicles and associated items, have been created by people just like you, who have worked their sweet asses off to create something special.

Like everything at AfrikaBurn, theme camps are subject to change at all times ... where camps have not given specific times of their activities, please feel free to pop past and ask politely when they'd like you to participate with them. Where camps have given specific times, don't expect the thing to happen exactly at that time either.

ABnB

Nestled in the dust, you will find a safe haven for those of you looking to chill and connect. Equipped with a large lounge area, cocktail bar, mutant and some deep soft-ish tunes. You may want to stay for an hour, a night or a day; the choice is yours.

Open: *All day*

Kids are welcome at certain times.

Please check first.

Ain't Misbehavin'

Swing into a jazzy world of vintage flair with Ain't Misbehavin'. Find us Inside on the Southside, putting on our Shiny Stockings so we can Jive at Five ... Swing dancing with a specially-built wooden dance floor. Morning mimosas, afternoon lessons, evening socials, late-night blues...

Open: *Monday to Saturday at 5pm - A*

Different Swing Dance Lesson. Tuesday at

9pm - Cabaret Night. Wednesday at 10:30am

- Social Waltz & Mimosas. Monday to Saturday 6pm to late - Social Swing & Blues Dancing

Kids are welcome at all times.

Alegra Space Station

Alegra Space Station is the Tankwa equivalent of the ISS. We welcome the travelling burner and then make them work and gift. Our camp is gifting coffee to wake you up in the mornings and Sangria to soothe you in the afternoons. Find us and make new friends.

Open: *Morning and afternoons*

Adults only.

Ambient Naartjie

Loki

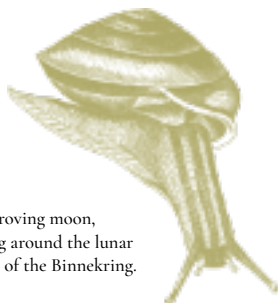

Why Not CREATION

A two-floor mobile stage in the Binnekring & in the Why Not camp. There will be a sound system, chilling area, and dancing area.

Wolf Bike

AWOOoooooooooooo. The Wolf Bike started as a scooter, but the only things that are left of the original scooter are the engine, the front wheel (for now) and the bit of the frame that connects the triple clamp to the swing arm. The rest of the bike is wolf.


Zeus

The sky and thunder god in ancient Greek religion and Mutant Vehicle mythology, who rules as king of the gods on the Binnekring. Loud, straight piped, fully roadworthy, fully operational.

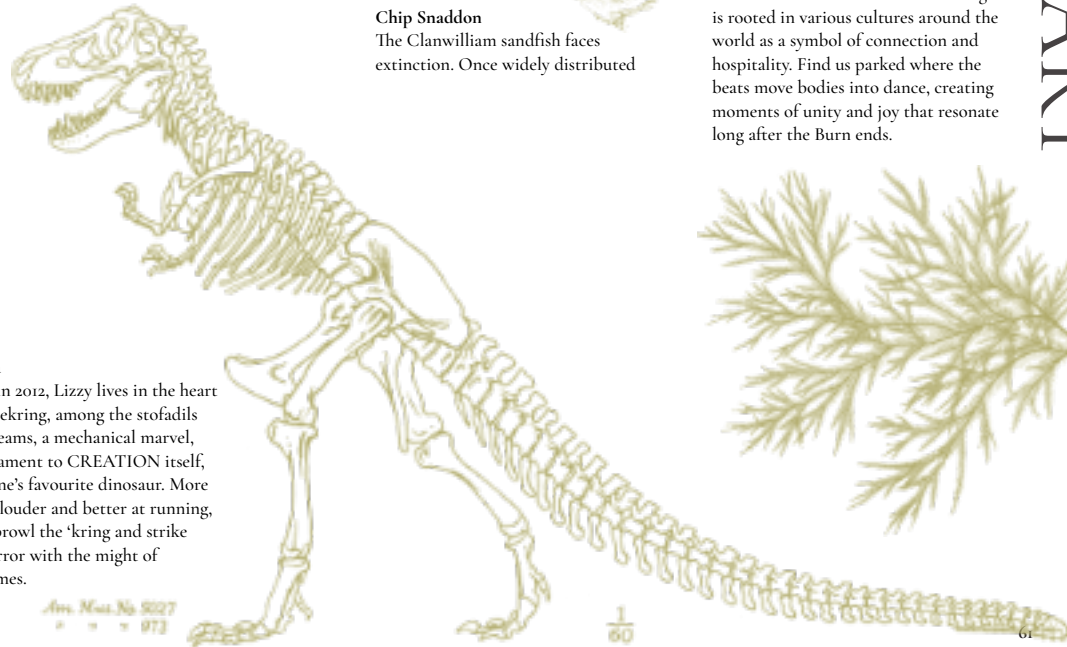
Inkanyamba

Apart from all the heat, wind, rain, dust, sticky-out bits of rebar, hangovers, scorpions, wind spiders, locusts, rabid riverine rabbits and stofadils, AfrikaBurn is one of the safest spaces to invent your world anew.

We have a number of safety and security structures in place to make sure you're as safe as possible in Tankwa Town ... We have a brilliant security community of Event Guardians who are professionally trained and entirely focused on your safety and security who you'll see on the ground all over the event site. We also have the South African Police Service on site, if you see them please show them some love and respect ... and don't flaunt any illegal behaviour in their faces.

Our Rangers are the foundation of a fun and safe AfrikaBurn experience. You'll see them wearing orange in Tankwa Town, doing the 'Ranger walk' and dishing out high-5s, advice and support. They've all got radios and know the drill - so if anything happens that makes you feel unsafe or unsure, you can find someone wearing orange and ask them for help.

Things go missing all the time at AfrikaBurn, and usually ends up at Lost & Found. However, on some occasions portable possessions like phones, wallets, cameras and shoes can go walk-about. If something has gone missing and has not turned up at Lost & Found, please also report it to our security team at our operations center.

Consent at AfrikaBurn is exactly the same as anywhere else in South Africa. Nudity, skimpy clothes, or a saucy wink is not an invitation to have sex or any form of intimate physical contact.

The only form of consent in Tankwa Town is a clearly spoken invitation. Ignoring someone's inability or unwillingness to consent not only contradicts the spirit of our AfrikaBurn community but is also a crime.

As much as we all believe Tankwa Town is a utopia, sexual trauma, abuse and rape have happened in the past. Please look out for each other and help to eradicate it from Tankwa Town and beyond.

Consent at AfrikaBurn applies to more than just sexual encounters ...

Touch: *Just because you hugged someone yesterday doesn't mean you can surprise them with a hug today. 'Surprise contact' isn't always wanted, even if it's affectionate.*

Kink: *Consent for one thing isn't consent for another. If I said 'you can spank me', that doesn't give you permission to grope me.*

Sex: *Consent can be revoked once it's been given.*

Gifts: *Disclose what is in your gifts, even if it's just essential oils. Some people have sensitivities.*

Foods: *Disclose the ingredients, one person's innocuous ingredient can be someone else's allergy.*



Emergency Support: STAR: sexual trauma and assault response
AfrikaBurn has a zero tolerance policy for, and processes in place, to address consent violations. Support and care in the event of sexual violence is available 24/7. This includes sexual harassment or intimate partner abuse, and escalates to full support in the event of sexual assault. *Somebody being creepy or predatory? Is someone ignoring the media consent bracelet or spiking drinks? We want to help. Just ask anyone with a radio, Guardian Angel or Ranger for STAR.*

Support: psych crisis care
A team of mental health professionals provide 24/7 care and support with mental health emergencies in the dust. Ask anyone with a radio to call for Support, and we will assist you.

Tankwa Town can be quite noisy, with all sorts of crashes, bangs and wallops happening day and night. Most of the sound camps are located on the top of the Binnekring by 12ish, making this the 'louder zone', with things in Tankwa Town getting ever so slightly quieter the further back one goes from 12ish down to 1ish.

There are two **Quiet Camping Areas at AfrikaBurn**: one behind the dunes on 3ish and 4ish roads, and one behind the dunes on 9ish and 10ish roads. These areas are to be free of generators and any amplified music at all times. We can't guarantee total silence at AfrikaBurn, but in this camping area, at least your neighbours won't be blasting Tay Tay all week on a shitty Bluetooth speaker.

While CREATION is still fresh in your mind, and before it's erased by the default world experience, we'd love to know what you thought of your AfrikaBurn experience this year. We've put together a participant survey for you to please fill in if you just scan the QR code below when you're back home. We'll also send you a POEPHOL email reminder when you get home.

We use all this information to try and make better decisions for what will come after CREATION. It takes about 20 minutes, which might feel like an eternity online - but is well worth it.

Quiet Camping Area: No generators or amplified music at any time.

General Camping: No generators or amplified music between midnight to 11am.

Binnekring: Sound shut off at 2am, Monday to Thursday.

Louder Zone: Sound shut off at 7am, Monday to Thursday.

Quiet Hours: No generators or amplified music 7am to 11am, Monday to Thursday anywhere in Tankwa Town except for Theme Camps offering a morning gift*.

CREATION ends at midnight on Sunday. We ask that from 10pm on Sunday the volume of music is lowered as the event winds down to a close at midnight. This is a **HARD CUT OFF** - no amplified music after this time. This is non negotiable.
